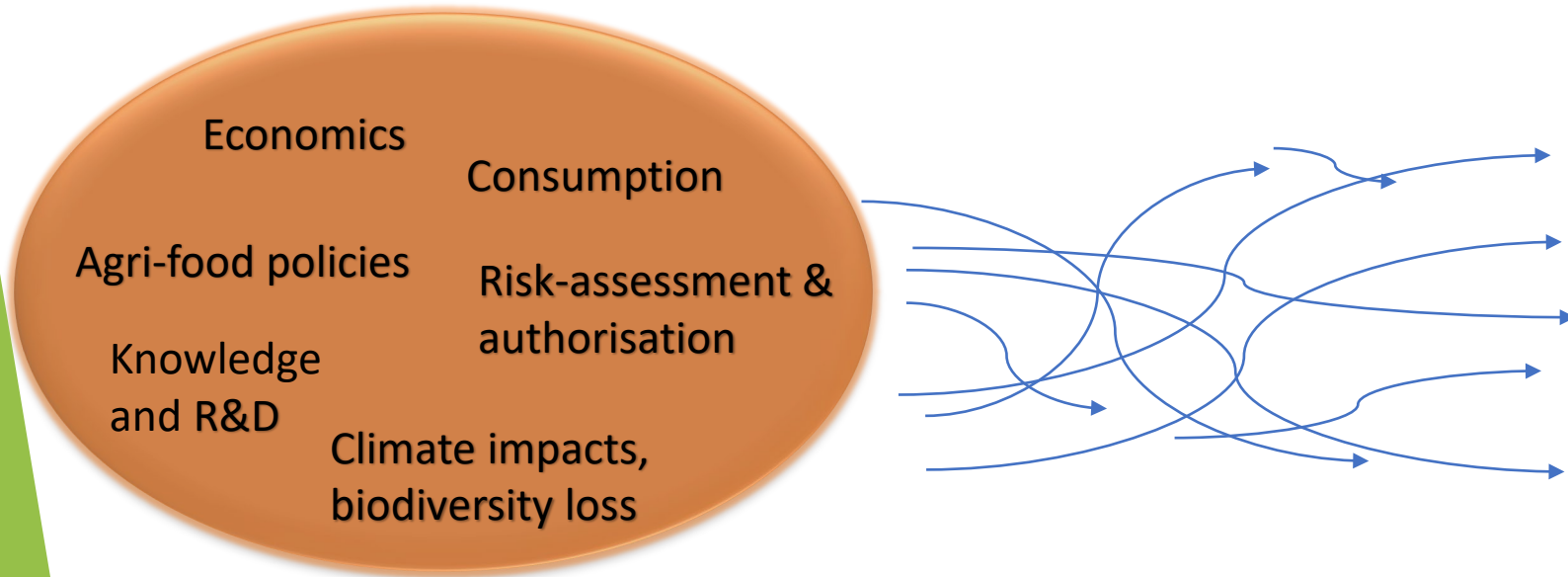

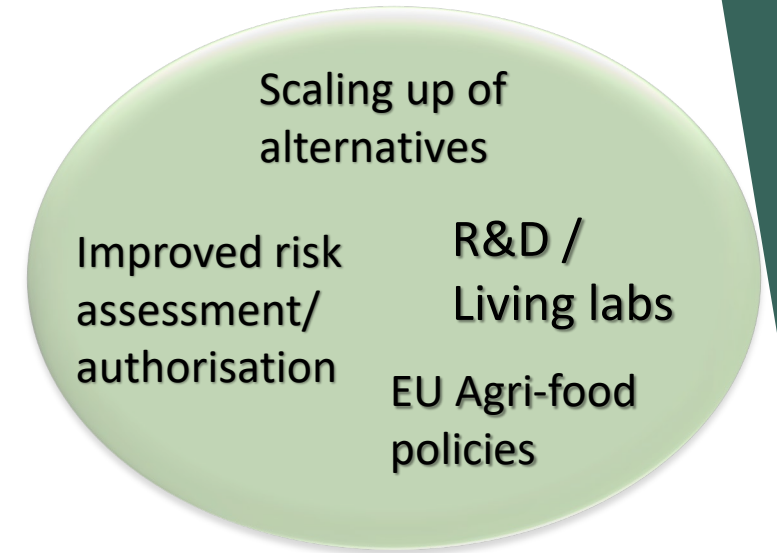
Aims

Current lock-ins and barriers to reduced pesticide use

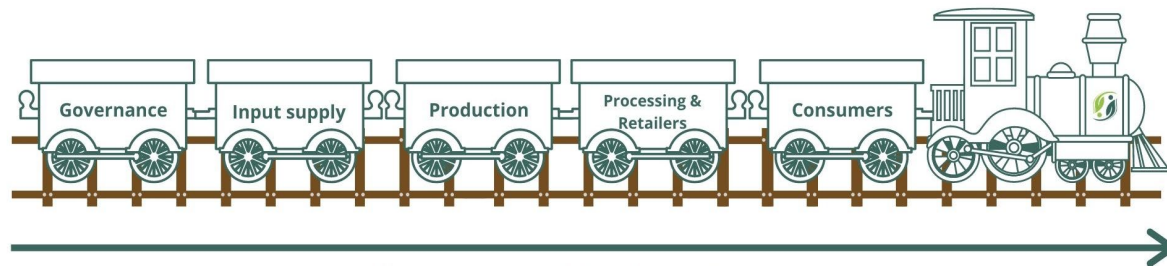


Stakeholder vision(s) of sustainable plant protection

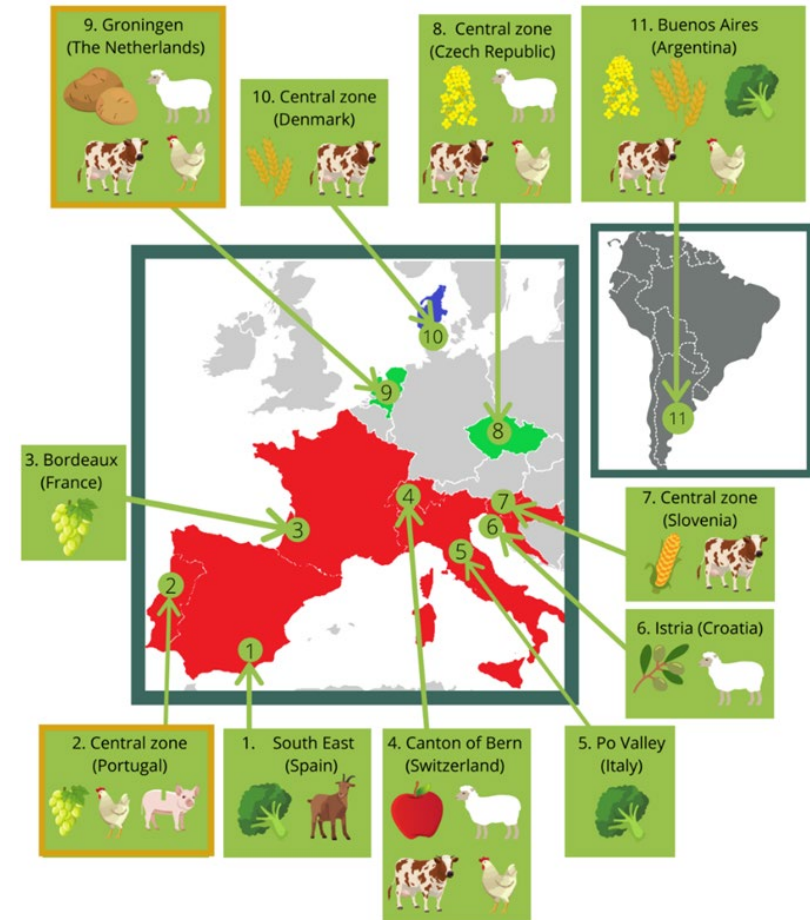


- Task 1: Analysis of barriers and lock-ins
